

Privacy Statement

Thank you for visiting the Breeze Training Pty Ltd website (www.breeze.net). Breeze Training Pty Ltd also uses the trading name "Breeze" and the company name is referred to as "Breeze". This privacy statement helps you understand how we collect and use information collected from our online site and gives you the ability to make an informed decision about using the site.

Breeze Training Pty Ltd is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Privacy Statement applies to the Breeze Training Pty Ltd Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the Breeze Training Pty Ltd website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

PRIVACY ACT

We wish to ensure that people engaging with us know that we will respect their personal information and use it appropriately. We are bound by the National Privacy Principles ("NPPs") under the Privacy Act 1998 and always seek to apply those principles in our dealing with personal information.

Breeze Training Pty Ltd (ACN 085 353 715) is bound by the provisions of the Commonwealth Privacy Act 1998 and the Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000 which started operation on 21 December 2001.

Breeze Training Pty Ltd has adopted this Privacy Statement to ensure that it handles personal information about an individual in accordance with the Act.

Our Privacy Statement may be amended in accordance with any new legislative requirements. Any amendments to our statement will be published on our website.

Collection of your Personal Information

Breeze Training Pty Ltd collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Breeze Training Pty Ltd also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your post code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favourites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Breeze Training Pty Ltd. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by Breeze Training Pty Ltd for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Breeze Training Pty Ltd Web site.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Breeze Training Pty Ltd public discussion groups including blogs, this information may be collected and used by others. Use of your Personal Information

Breeze Training Pty Ltd collects and uses your personal information to operate the Breeze Training Pty Ltd Web site and deliver the services you have requested. Breeze Training Pty Ltd also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Breeze Training Pty Ltd and its affiliates. Breeze Training Pty Ltd may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Breeze Training Pty Ltd does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Breeze Training Pty Ltd may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Breeze Training Pty Ltd may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Breeze Training Pty Ltd, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your

information.

Breeze Training Pty Ltd does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Breeze Training Pty Ltd keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within Breeze Training Pty Ltd, in order to determine what Breeze Training Pty Ltd services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customised content and advertising within Breeze Training Pty Ltd to customers whose behaviour indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Breeze Training Pty Ltd Web sites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Breeze Training Pty Ltd or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Breeze Training Pty Ltd; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Breeze Training Pty Ltd, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Breeze Training Pty Ltd Web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page.
